



LAKE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. A state fishing license is required in accordance with the conservation code. A city license is not required at Rothwell, Water Works, Deer Pond, or Beuth pond for daytime fishing.
2. Overnight (during parks curfew of 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.) fishing permits are required and may be purchased from the Parks and Recreation office at 200 N Clark St.
3. Annual boat storage fees are \$50. Boats that are delinquent on payment will be locked up with a City lock and chain. Boats that are delinquent for a significant amount of time may be considered abandoned property.
4. Other rules and regulations are as follows:
 - Motors have a no wake speed limit. Boats may not exceed 10 m.p.h.
 - Each boat must have one (1) U. S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket or preserver per person on board. Minors and anyone unable to swim must be wearing it at all times.
 - All boats must be properly licensed and permitted in accordance with Missouri State laws.
 - All boats shall reduce to slow speed when approaching anchored boats, ramp areas and shoreline fishermen.
 - All boaters shall practice boating courtesy and water safety rules while on the lake.
 - The rules and regulations of the Missouri Conservation Commission's Wildlife Code must be observed at all times.
 - Swimming, waterskiing, diving, ice skating, and ice fishing are prohibited in all lakes.
 - Disposal of wastes in provided receptacles only. No littering!
 - No jugs, trout lines, or traps permitted.
