The City of Moberly decided it will be closing all public facilities following the close of business Wednesday, March 18th, 2020 until further notice. These facilities include; lobby spaces at City Hall, Fire Departments, Public Works, Public Utilities, and Parks and Recreation. The Police Department will keep its front lobby open but limit direct interaction. This is being done in order to minimize social contact among the general public and city staff to ensure continued delivery of services (Fire, Parks, Police, Water, Sewer, Streets, etc.) to residents.
